 - a. Both were from the tribe of Levi of the family of Aaron (cf. <u>Lev. 1:5</u>; <u>Lk. 1:8-9</u>; <u>Num. 16:36-40</u>)
 - b. Both were righteous before God (Lk. 1:6)
 - c. Both were old and had no child (Lk. 1:7)
- 2. John promised (<u>Lk. 1:8-14</u>)
- 3. John's purpose (<u>Lk. 1:15-17</u>)
- 4. John's pleasure (<u>Lk. 1:39-45</u>)

 - c. Christ gave John the highest praise (Mt. 11:7-15)
- 2. Trading eternal life for the sparing of physical life is foolishness (Mt. 16:25-26)
 - a. John suffered a martyr's death but gained eternal life
 - b. His voice and actions stand as witnesses to doing the will of God
