

Introduction

1. God is the Creator [Maker] and the Almighty (cf. [Job 36:3, 37:23](#))
 - a. He is also the source of wisdom, knowledge, and understanding ([Pr. 2:6](#))
 - b. “Great is our Lord, and of great power: His understanding is infinite.” ([Ps. 147:5](#))
2. Job began to learn from Elihu and God Himself the completeness of God’s knowledge
 - a. In comparison to God, we know very little (cf. [Job 38-41](#))
 - b. We, like Job, should acknowledge the great knowledge of God ([Job 42:1-3](#))

The Vastness of God’s Knowledge

1. God knows the end from the beginning ([Isa. 46:10](#))
 - a. No one can search out His understanding ([Isa. 40:28](#); [Rm. 11:33-34](#))
2. God knows minute details
 - a. The count of our hairs ([Lk. 12:7](#))
 - b. The count of the stars ([Ps. 147:4](#))
 - c. The water, atmosphere, dust, mountains, and hills ([Isa. 40:12](#))
3. God knows all of our thoughts [the contents of the heart] ([Ezek. 11:5](#))
 - a. God tries the heart ([Jer. 17:9-10](#), cf. [Jer. 20:12](#))
 - b. God looks upon the heart ([1 Sam. 16:7](#))
 - c. God is greater than our heart which includes our conscience ([1 Jn. 3:20](#))
 - d. Jesus knew the thoughts of people ([Mt. 9:1-8](#))
 - i. In Christ is hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge ([Col. 2:2-3](#))
 - e. We should acknowledge this attribute of God in our prayers ([1 Kgs. 8:37-40](#); cf. [2 Chr. 6:30](#); [Acts 1:24](#))
4. God knows all our words and our doings ([Ps. 139:1-6](#))
 - a. This provides comfort for the righteous ([Ps. 139:23-24](#))
 - b. This should cause fear for the unrighteous but sometimes it does not ([Jer. 4:14](#), [22](#))

The Vengeance of God’s Knowledge

1. Every sin is an offense toward God ([Gen. 39:9](#); cf. [1 Sam. 2:25](#))
 - a. Our sin will find us out ([Num. 32:23](#))
 - b. Sin is the violation of God’s Perfect Law ([1 Jn. 3:4](#); [2 Jn. 9](#); [Jm. 4:17](#))
2. Vengeance belongs to God because He is All-Knowing ([Rm. 12:19](#); cf. [Dt. 32:35](#); [Ps. 94:1](#); [Heb. 10:30-31](#))
3. God will bring every work with every secret thing into judgment ([Ecc. 12:13-14](#); [2 Cor. 5:10-11](#))
4. Case in point: Ananias and Sapphira ([Acts 5:1-11](#))

The Victory of God's Knowledge

1. God's people of old were destroyed for a lack of knowledge ([Hos. 4:6](#))
 - a. This was willful rejection of God's Word
 - b. The same occurs today ([2 Pt. 3:3-9](#))
2. God has revealed His will so that we can follow it
 - a. The Old Law ([Dt. 29:29](#))
 - i. "The sum of thy word is truth; And every one of thy righteous ordinances *endureth* for ever." ([Ps. 119:160](#) ASV)
 - ii. We must treasure up God's Word in our hearts ([Ps. 119:11](#))
 - iii. We must meditate upon God's Word ([Ps. 119:15-16](#))
 - b. The New Law ([Jn. 1:17](#); [Eph. 5:17](#); [Rm. 12:1-2](#))
 - c. Heaven is reserved only for those that do the will of the Father ([Mt. 7:21-23](#))
3. We must know The Way and by extension the Father ([Jn. 14:1-9](#))
 - a. Taught of God ([Jn. 6:44-45](#))
 - i. We must learn of Christ ([Mt. 11:28-30](#))
 - ii. Grace teaches ([Titus 2:11-14](#))
 - b. Victory is in Christ ([1 Cor. 15:53-58](#))
 - i. Justification comes about through knowledge ([Isa. 53:11](#); [Rm. 10:13-17](#))
 - ii. Christianity is a taught religion ([Jer. 31:31-34](#); [Jn. 3:1-5](#))
 - c. Faith is the victory ([1 Jn. 5:1-4](#))
 - i. Only one faith ([Eph. 4:5](#))
 - ii. The faith has been once and for all time delivered ([Jude 3](#))
4. We must encourage others to know and obey Christ ([Mt. 28:18-20](#); [Mk. 16:15-16](#); [Lk. 24:46-47](#))
