Introduction

- 1. God's holiness requires that His church be holy (1 Pt. 1:15-16)
 - a. The church is the body of Christ (Col. 1:18)
 - i. Christ is the Holy One (Acts 3:14)
 - b. Holiness is not only possible, but also required if we wish to see God (<u>Heb.</u> 12:14)
- 2. An examination of the church and holiness is in order
 - a. The church is a holy priesthood
 - b. The church is a holy nation

The Church is a Holy Priesthood

- 1. Jesus Christ is the Holy High Priest (Heb. 3:1, 7:26-28)
- 2. Under the Old Law, the priests came from the tribe of Levi of the order of Aaron (Heb. 7:5, 11)
 - a. The priesthood has been changed and so has the law (Heb. 7:12)
- 3. Every Christian is not just a priest, but must be a holy priest (1 Pt. 2:5)
 - a. This is contrary to Catholic teaching that only certain trained men can be priests
 - Instead of fleshly sacrifices, the Christian offers <u>spiritual</u> sacrifices to God which is directly related to our worship (<u>Mt. 4:10</u>; <u>Jn. 4:20-24</u>; <u>Heb. 12:28</u>; cf. <u>Phil. 4:18</u>; <u>Heb. 13:15-16</u>)
 - i. Holy men are to lead in worship (<u>1 Tim. 2:8</u>; cf. "him that is godly" <u>Ps.</u> <u>4:3</u> = "Holy One" <u>Ps. 16:10</u>)
 - ii. Not just anyone can approach God in worship acceptably (Num. 16:5)
 - iii. If holiness is lacking in worship, tragedy occurs (Lev. 10:1-3)

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The Church is a Holy Nation

- 1. Israel of old was to be God's holy people (Ex. 19:6)
 - a. They often failed at this intent (cf. Ex. 32)
- 2. Today, God's holy people is the church (1 Pt. 2:9)
 - a. Which church? Just one! (Eph. 1:22-23, 4:4)
 - b. The church of Christ is the Israel of God (Gal. 6:16)
- 3. The church has been called out of darkness [wickedness; sin; ignorance] and into Christ's marvelous light
 - a. This demands holiness for light is set apart from darkness (<u>2 Cor. 6:14-7:1</u>; cf. <u>Ezek. 22:26</u>; <u>Lev. 10:8-11</u>)
 - b. Tragedy comes to those who go back to the darkness (2 Pt. 2:20-22)

Conclusion

- 1. Our hearts must be dedicated to the Lord God (1 Pt. 3:15)
 - a. We are set apart for His use!
- 2. This world is not going to last (2 Pt. 3:10)
 - a. Holy living now will see to it that we have eternal life later (2 Pt. 3:11-18)
