## Introduction

- 1. A home begins at marriage when one man and one woman are joined together by God for one lifetime (<u>Gen. 2:18-25; Mt. 19:4-6; 1 Cor. 7:39</u>)
- God placed the sexual relationship within, and only within, marriage (<u>Heb.</u> <u>13:4</u>)
- 3. Once children are added to the home, roles are expanded
- 4. God's roles of father and mother must be reverenced for the home to be as God intended it to be

## I. The Role of the Father

- 1. Fathers have the primary responsibility to rear their children (Eph. 6:4)
- 2. Fathers must teach their children God's Word (<u>Dt. 6:1-9</u>; cf. <u>Dt. 11:18-21</u>)
- 3. Fathers must set up memorials that result in fearing the LORD (Jos. 4:19-24)
- 4. Fathers must make the choice for their families that they will serve the LORD (Jos. 24:15)

## II. The Role of the Mother

- Mothers must work together with fathers in rearing their children (<u>Pr. 1:8</u>, 6:20)
- 2. Mothers must love their children (Tit. 2:4)
- 3. Mothers must be homemakers (<u>Tit. 2:5</u>)
